During October, The Turkic American Alliance attended various meetings on Capitol Hill with staff from three of its Member Federations: the Turkic American Federation of Midwest (TAFM), the Western Turkic American Council (WTAC) and the Council of Turkic American Associations (CTAA). The purpose of these meetings was to conduct outreach initiatives and to invite Members of Congress to events organized by TAA's respective Member Federations. TAA and its Member Federation staffers also had the privilege to attend a private meeting with the Honorable Ali Babacan, Turkey's Deputy Prime Minister for Economic and Financial Affairs.

Additionally, one of TAA's member organizations, Rumi Forum, hosted its 7th Annual Rumi Peace and Dialogue Awards, as well as a two-day International Symposium on the Hizmet Movement and Peacebuilding. TAA had the honor of hosting dinner for distinguished guests and panelists at its offices on one of the nights during the Symposium. The Hizmet Movement is a non-centralized, international social movement inspired by the teachings of Fethullah Gülen, a distinguished contemporary Turkish scholar of Islam. Core tenets of the movement are interfaith and intercultural dialogue, in addition to high-caliber education in private school settings worldwide that specializes in mathematics and the physical sciences while also paying focused attention to the spiritual development of each and every one of its students. These schools are not religiously affiliated; rather, they emphasize humanitarian values of love, empathy and peace.
