Dear Friends,

This month has been a trying one for Turkey. In the direct aftermath of the controversy surrounding the government's decision to close private prep schools, an egregious graft inquiry involving cabinet members and national and international business persons swept most headlines. Over the past few weeks, this inquiry guickly snowballed into a political crisis gripping an ever-polarized nation, due largely to obstructive attempts by the government to deflect current charges and to curtail further inquiries through a massive restructuring of the cabinet, bureaucracy and police forces. Furthermore, the Turkish public has been subjected to a steady vilification of certain actors, conspiratorial paranoia and political strong-arming of the media, judiciary and bureaucracy. We hope and pray for a speedy return to normalcy and for a sincere recognition and remediation of these illadvised decisions. Please find more details about this issue in the policy paper published by the Rethink Institute, also included in this newsletter.

In other news, the Turkic American Alliance co-organized with the Embassy of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the Council of Turkic American Associations, the Turquoise Council of Americans and Eurasians, and the Kazakh American Friendship Council, the First Annual U.S.-Kazakhstan Convention. This premier event was a huge success and was attended by many individuals, among them 20 U.S. Members of Congress and 2 U.S. Senators.

Earlier in December, the Honorable Kemal Kılıçdaroğlu, Chairman of Turkey's Republican People's Party (CHP), and a CHP delegation of 7 MPs visited the Turkic American Alliance. TAA also had audiences with His Excellency the Ambassador of Ghana and the Executive Director of the National Lieutenant Governors Association.
