Dear Friends.

This month, the Turkic American Alliance was very honored to have hosted a distinguished delegation of Lieutenant Governors at its office in conjunction with the annual winter meetings by the National Association of Lieutenant Governors. Eleven LGs attended this premier event, in addition to representatives of TUSKON, Nema Food Company and other local businesspersons. Be sure to also check out highlights from the Georgia-Turkey State Capitol Reception in Atlanta, the annual Dialogue and Friendship Dinner held in Honolulu, Hawai'i, and an important J-1 Visa orientation in New York City.

Municipal elections took place in Turkey on March 30th. The Justice and Development Party (AKP) maintained 46% of the vote, while the Republican People's Party (CHP) obtained 28%, the Nationalist Movement Party (MHP) 15% and the Peace and Democracy Party (BDP) 4%. We hope that the results will inspire more democratic conditions in Turkey. In the aftermath of the elections, the Turkic American Alliance is deeply concerned over countless reports of voting irregularities, including wide-ranging electrical blackouts, vote rigging, vote counting obstruction and strategic delaying, and cyber attacks against independent news agencies, newspapers and television channels. In addition, social media sites Twitter and YouTube were blocked earlier this month, seriously jeopardizing freedom of speech and expression in Turkey. Statements to this affect were issued publicly by U.S. State Department spokespersons, European Union Commissioners, U.S. Members of Congress and the White House Press Secretary.

On a lighter note, March is also the month of Nowruz. According to the United Nations, Nowruz is a spring festival that is celebrated globally by over 300 million people as the beginning of the New Year. Such celebrations have taken place for over 3,000 years in the Balkans, the Black Sea Basin, the Caucasus, Central Asia, the Middle East and other regions. This year, TAA staff attended a Nowruz reception at the White House, and
