Dear Friends.

This month, Turkey witnessed two historical events--its first direct presidential election on August 10th, with Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdoğan emerging victorious, and the inauguration of the President-elect on August 28th. The former Foreign Minister, Ahmet Davutoğlu, has been selected as the new Prime Minister. Now only at the nascent beginnings of this new political reality, the Turkic American Alliance wishes nothing but the best for Turkey and urges its government to stay due course towards a liberal democracy and towards the strengthening freedoms of press, speech, association and free enterprise and reifying the separation of powers between the executive and the judiciary.

In other firsts, the Turkic American Alliance was honored to be a part of the U.S.-Africa Leaders Summit, which took place in Washington, D.C., during August 4th-6th. In concurrence with this summit, TAA attended high-profile meetings and events, such as the D.C. Mayor's Welcome Reception, a luncheon with His Excellency Jacob Zuma, President of the Republic of South Africa, 'A Dialogue with African CEOs' hosted by Congressman Gregory Meeks, a luncheon with His Excellency John Dramani Mahama, President of the Republic of Ghana, a luncheon with His Excellency Goodluck Jonathan, President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, and a dinner with His Excellency Uhuru Kenyatta, President of the Republic of Kenya.

Additionally, TAA hosted at its office headquarters His Excellency Erastus Mwencha, Deputy Chairperson of the African Union Commission, and Jean-Baptiste Natama, Chief of Staff to the Chairperson of the African Union Commission. TAA also received a delegation of Tanzanian businesspersons from Tanzania's private sector.

In other news, the Turkic American Alliance was invited to speak at Sister Cities International's 58th Annual Conference in San Jose, California, before the 'Vulnerable Populations in the Middle East' panel. Additionally, TAA was invited to attend the National Conference of State Legislatures' annual Legislative Summit in Minneapolis to deliver a speech before a panel deliberating on the 'Geopolitics of Energy.' 

Fethullah Gülen Releases Statement on ISIS


